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<b>Unit Code and Title</b>	HLTAID002 Provide basic emergency life support
<b>About the course</b>	Whether for work, sport, leisure activities or home – the ability to provide basic emergency life support can save someone’s life. This course will provide you with an opportunity to gain the knowledge and skills required to provide an emergency response in a range of situations, including community, sport, event and workplace settings.
<b>RTO Selection criteria</b>	<p>Course applicants must meet the following selection criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• satisfactory completion of a language, literacy and numeracy test, and</li> <li>• have the physical capacity to complete the practical requirements of the course.</li> </ul>
<b>Course Duration and Schedule</b>	<p><b>Duration:</b></p> <p>The course is completed over 1 day</p> <p>7.30am – 3.15pm</p>
<b>Location of training</b>	All training will be conducted at Parade College.
<b>Training and assessment methods</b>	<p><b>Training methods</b></p> <p>Training methods include face to face, classroom based trainer led presentations. Students will also have opportunities to develop practical skills with trainer coaching and supervision.</p>
	<p><b>Assessment methods</b></p> <p>A range of assessment methods are used throughout the course including practical skill demonstrations and a written test. You will receive detailed assessment information on commencement of the course.</p>
<b>Course requirements</b>	There is no specialist clothing, equipment or material requirements for this course.
<b>RPL</b>	<p>Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) recognises the knowledge and skills you have gained through previous informal training, and past work and life experience.</p> <p>If you think that you might be able to apply for RPL, talk to the Executive Officer - RTO preferably before course</p>
