About the course	Whether for work, sport, leisure activities or home – the ability to perform first aid can save someone’s life. This course will provide you with an opportunity to gain the knowledge and skills required to provide first aid in a variety of situations and to a variety of casualties.

Location of training	All training will be conducted at Parade College.
Training and assessment methods	<p>Training methods</p> <p>Training methods include face to face, classroom based trainer led presentations. Students will also have opportunities to develop practical skills with trainer coaching and supervision.</p>
	<p>Assessment methods</p> <p>A range of assessment methods are used throughout the course including practical skill demonstrations and a written test. You will receive detailed assessment information on commencement of the course.</p>
Course requirements	There is no specialist clothing, equipment or material requirements for this course.
