








#### **Sport Academy**

## What is Applied Learning?

Students apply what they have learnt by utilising the learning cycle of doing, experiencing, reflecting and relating new knowledge and skills to the real world.

Catering for individual student needs, using authentic materials and resources drawn from everyday life rather than mass-produced textbooks or materials.

Utilising the experience and knowledge of community members including employers, cultural and community leaders and former students.

Learning reflects the integration that occurs in real-life tasks, incorporating skills and knowledge relevant to the whole task and the whole person such as collaboration, communication, problem solving and interpersonal skills.

Presenting learning activities in different modalities: visual, auditory and kinaesthetic, to allow the greatest uptake of knowledge.

#### **Edmund Rice Pathways Program (ERPP)**

The Edmund Rice Pathways Program (ERPP) is a Year 10 Applied Learning program. Students who undertake ERPP move into the VCE Vocational Major (VCE VM) in Year 11 and 12. The ERPP and VCE VM programs run at the Preston Campus.

Students undertake the following core subjects:

- English
- Maths
- Community Based Religion
- Careers
- STEM
- Physical Activity

VET is an integral part of ERPP and students undertake the following VET courses:

- Carpentry plus one of:
- Bricklaying
- Furniture Making
- Sport and Recreation

#### Features of the Edmund Rice Pathways Program (ERPP)

- Extended work experience opportunities two weeks workplace learning at the end of every term (on average 40 days over the school year)
- Applied Learning hands-on learning, project based curriculum, focus on employability skills, related to work and life.



## VCE Vocational Major

Year 10 into Year 11 The new VCE Vocational Major (VCE VM) replaced the VCAL Certificate in 2023. VCE VM has been introduced as part of the Department of Education's Senior Secondary education reforms. All students undertaking Year 11 and 12 at Parade College (and every other school in Victoria) undertake the VCE as of 2023.

The VCE Vocational Major is unscored.

Students complete school assessed coursework and assessment tasks, they do not sit exams.

VET is a compulsory feature of the VCE Vocational Major.

### VCE Vocational Major

All students must undertake the four core VCE Vocational Major subjects and VET

#### Core subjects

- Literacy
- Numeracy
- Personal Development Skills
- Work Related Skills

To be eligible to receive the VCE VM, students must undertake 180 hours of VET at Certificate II or above.

A range of VET options offered by the Parade RTO and external providers are available for students to choose from. Please see the VET offerings information which is available as part the subject selection resources for a list of all available VET courses.






