#### SENIOR SPORT ACADEMY ENROLMENT

### **Selection Criteria**

Selection for the Sport Academy is based on the following criteria:

- Evidence of academic ability to pursue undergraduate studies
- A desire to pursue a career in the sport industry
- Demonstrated ability in a Sport at an elite level
- Previous ACC (or similar School Competition) involvement and performance
- Involvement and performance in regular Physical Education classes
- General conduct and ability to demonstrate mutual respect to peers and staff
- Performance at Selection Trials
- Ability to uphold Parade College's Discipline and Uniform Policies
- Performance in local sporting competitions

Students whose application is short-listed will be required to attend an interview.



#### Curriculum

Students undertaking the Sport Academy will complete the following subjects:

### **Year 11 (Year 1)**

- SIS30122 VET Certificate III Sport, Aquatics & Recreation Program
- Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) OR Industry-focused projects and mentoring

Year 12 (Year 2) (Entry into the second year is conditional upon successful completion of all Year 11 Subjects)

- SIS40421 VET Certificate IV Sport Development
- Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) OR Industry-focused projects & mentoring







# SPORT ACADEMY AND VCE VOCATIONAL MAJOR

Students in Years 11 and 12 can participate in the Sport Academy and complete the VCE Vocational Major (Year 1) in Year 11 and the VCE Vocational Major (Year 2) in Year 12. This program is offered at both our Bundoora and Preston Campuses.

The VCE Vocational Major is a senior school certificate that provides pathways for Years 11 and 12 students seeking vocationally orientated career options such as traineeships, further education and training, or employment.

The Sport Academy VCE Vocational Major is ideal for:

- Students who want to pursue tertiary studies at La Trobe University
- Students seeking a vocational pathway beyond Year 12
- Students who learn best through practical, experiential, and applied learning
- Students who want to include a traineeship, or industry focused projects and mentoring, in their program.

# **Typical Weekly Program**

- 2x ½ days of Curriculum Content: Numeracy, Literacy, Personal Development and Work - Related Skills, and Tenete (RE).
- 2x ½ days of delivering skills and coaching sessions
- 1 full day of Workplace Learning OR Industry-focused projects and mentoring
- 1x ½ days of Sport: skills, squad, strength, conditioning, delivering skills / coaching sessions.










